The A580 Trunk Road (Haydock Island Circulatory Carriageway) (Prohibition of Right Turns) Order 2010

The Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 1(1) and 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as The A580 Trunk Road (Haydock Island Circulatory Carriageway) (Prohibition of Right Turns) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 7 June 2010.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A580 Trunk Road in the District of St Helens in Merseyside;

"the circulatory carriageway" means the circulatory carriageway of the trunk road at Haydock Island (M6 Motorway Junction 23);

"the eastbound through carriageway" means the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road which passes through the centre of the circulatory carriageway;

"the westbound through carriageway" means the westbound carriageway of the trunk road which passes through the centre of the circulatory carriageway;

- 3. Subject as mentioned in article 5 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter the eastbound through carriageway by making a right turn from the west side of the circulatory carriageway.
- 4. Subject as mentioned in article 5 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter the westbound through carriageway by making a right turn from the east side of the circulatory carriageway.

5.	Nothing in	n articles 3	and 4 of this	Order shall	apply to:

- (a) any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance services or traffic officers; or
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable, or traffic officer in uniform.
