**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M5 Motorway (Junction 11A Southbound Exit Slip Road)  
(Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2010**

*Made* - - - - - *26 May 2010*  
*Coming into force* - - - - - *1 June 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M5 Motorway (“the M5”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads at Junction 11A in the County of Gloucestershire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M5 Motorway (Junction 11A Southbound Exit Slip Road) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 1 June 2010.

**2.** In this Order –

“the slip road” means the southbound exit slip road at M5 Junction 11A;

“the works” mean maintenance works in connection with the A417 Crickley Hill scheme;

“the works period” means the period starting at 09.00 hours on Thursday 3 June 2010 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the slip road.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.
