The Safety of Sports Grounds (Designation) (No.2) Order 2010

Made	22nd June 2010
Laid before Parliament	24th June 2010
Coming into force	19th July 2010

The Secretary of State makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1(1) of the Safety of Sports Grounds Act 1975(a). In accordance with section 18(4) of that Act he has consulted with such persons and bodies as appear to him to be requisite.

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Safety of Sports Grounds (Designation) (No.2) Order 2010 and comes into force on 19th July 2010.

Designation

2. The sports grounds specified in the Schedule to this Order, each being a sports ground—

- (a) at which association football matches are played;
- (b) which is occupied by a club which is a member of the Football League Limited; and
- (c) which, in the opinion of the Secretary of State, has accommodation for more than 5,000 spectators(b)

are each designated as a sports ground requiring a safety certificate under the Safety of Sports Grounds Act 1975.
