**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M60 Motorway (Junctions 4-3 Anticlockwise Carriageway)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

*Made* - - - - - *28 December 2010*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *16 January 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M60 Motorway and is satisfied that traffic on a section of that motorway in the Borough of Stockport in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M60 Motorway (Junctions 4-3, Anticlockwise Carriageway) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 16 January 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the M60 Motorway between Junctions 4 and 3;

“the tip of the nosing of the entry link road” means the first point where the link road joins the carriageway of the motorway;

“the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road” means the last point where the slip road leaves the carriageway of the motorway;

“the length of carriageway” means the anticlockwise carriageway of the motorway from the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road at Junction 4 to the tip of the nosing of the entry link road from the M56 Motorway at Junction 3;

“the works period” means periods over two nights between 2200 hours and 0500 hours during a period starting on Monday 17 January 2011 and ending on Monday 14 February 2011. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights, or continue overnight until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“works” means resurfacing and general maintenance works on the motorway;

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of carriageway.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance services or to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works or by traffic officers, or to anything done at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
