- 2. The appointed day for the following codes of practice coming into force is 6th April 2010—
 - (a) Code of Practice for the Welfare of Privately Kept Non-Human Primates(b);
 - (b) Code of Practice for the Welfare of Cats(c);
 - (c) Code of Practice for the Welfare of Dogs(d);
 - (d) Code of Practice for the Welfare of Horses, Ponies, Donkeys and their Hybrids(e).
