CHAPTER 1

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Introductory provisions

Interpretation of Part 6

59. In this Part—

- (a) “the assessment provisions” means regulations 61 (assessment of implications for European sites and European offshore marine sites) and 62 (considerations of overriding public interest); ^{F1}...
- (b) “the review provisions” means regulations 63 (review of existing decisions and consents) and 64 (consideration on review).

[^{F2}(c) any reference to—

- (i) the giving or granting of any consent, permission or other authorisation (except in the heading to any regulation or in any reference to any such heading), or
- (ii) directing that planning permission is deemed to be granted,

is to be taken, in relation to any authorisation which is capable of being varied or modified, to include a reference to the variation or modification of such a consent, permission or authorisation; and]

[^{F2}(d) the reference in regulation 61(1) to deciding to undertake a plan or project is to be taken to include a reference to deciding to vary any plan or project undertaken or to be undertaken by the competent authority.]
