Magistrates' Courts (Northern Ireland) Order 1981

- 133. In Article 13 (magistrates' courts rules)—
 - (a) after paragraph (3) insert—
 - "(3ZA) For the purposes of paragraphs (3A) to (3D), "relevant authority" means—
 - (a) in relation to magistrates' courts rules which deal (or would deal) with an excepted matter, the Lord Chancellor; and
 - (b) otherwise, the Department of Justice;

and for the purposes of this paragraph "deal with" and "excepted matter" have the same meanings as in the Northern Ireland Act 1998(1).";

- (b) in paragraphs (3A) and (3D) for "Lord Chancellor" substitute "relevant authority";
- (c) in paragraph (3B)—
 - (i) for "Lord Chancellor" substitute "relevant authority";
 - (ii) for "he" substitute "it".
