ROAD TRAFFIC

The M6 Motorway Junction 21A (Northbound and Southbound Link Roads to the M62 Eastbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - *16th May 2011*

Coming into force - - *5th June 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Motorway and its link roads, is satisfied that traffic on two of those link roads in the Borough of Warrington should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M6 Motorway Junction 21A (Northbound and Southbound Link Roads to the M62 Eastbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 5th June 2011.

2. In this Order;

“motorway” means the M6 Motorway;

“works” means resurfacing, road marking and loop cutting works on the motorway and link roads;

“the works period” means a period over five nights between 2200 hours and 0500 hours starting on Monday 6 June 2011 and ending on Saturday 11 June 2011. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue overnight until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“the first link road” means the link road leading from the northbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 21A to the eastbound carriageway of the M62 Motorway;

“the second link road” means the link road leading from the southbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 21A to the eastbound carriageway of the M62 Motorway;

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first or second link roads.
4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
