The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Her Majesty The Queen's Birthday Flypast) (Amendment) Regulations 2011

Made - - - - *2nd June 2011*
Coming into force - - *7th June 2011*

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying by reason of the intended flypast and associated rehearsals of a large formation of aircraft to commemorate Her Majesty The Queen's Birthday that are scheduled to take place during the period from 7th to 11th June 2011.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Her Majesty The Queen's Birthday Flypast) (Amendment) Regulations 2011 and come into force on 7th June 2011.
2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Her Majesty The Queen's Birthday Flypast) Regulations 2011(b) ("the principal Regulations") are amended as follows.
3. In paragraphs (1) to (3) of regulation 3 of the principal Regulations, for the words "beginning with 7th June and ending on 9th June" substitute "beginning with 8th June and ending on 10th June".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Her Majesty The Queen's Birthday Flypast) Regulations 2011 (S.I. 2011/1104) ("the principal Regulations") by amending the dates of the flying restrictions applicable to the rehearsals. These were originally to have been held between 7th and 9th June but will now be held between 8th and 10th June 2011.

Full details of the principal Regulations as amended by this Statutory Instrument will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
