Application for [F¹Type] examination **E+W+S**

14. An application for [F¹Type] examination to be performed in relation to a toy must—
- be made to [F²an approved] body;
 - be made in accordance with Module B;
 - include a description of the toy;
 - indicate the address at which the toy has been or will be manufactured; and
 - [F³... be accompanied by such fee as may be required by the body in accordance with regulation 50 (charging of fees [F⁴by approved] body).
