- 14. An application for [^{F1}Type] examination to be performed in relation to a toy must—
 - (a) be made to [^{F2}an approved] body;
 - (b) be made in accordance with Module B;
 - (c) include a description of the toy;
 - (d) indicate the address at which the toy has been or will be manufactured; and
 - (e) ^{F3}... be accompanied by such fee as may be required by the body in accordance with regulation 50 (charging of fees [^{F4}by approved] body).

Application for EC-type examination N.I.

14. An application for EC-type examination to be performed in relation to a toy must—

(a) be made to a notified body;

- (b) be made in accordance with Module B;
- (c) include a description of the toy;
- (d) indicate the address at which the toy has been or will be manufactured; and
- (e) if the application is made to a UK notified body, be accompanied by such fee as may be required by the body in accordance with regulation 50 (charging of fees by UK notified body).
