**The Morpeth School, Oaklands School  
and Swanlea School Order 2011**

**Relaxation of requirements in relation to pupils over compulsory school age**

**3.** The following requirements are relaxed in relation to the Governing Bodies as they apply in relation to pupils who are over compulsory school age<sup>(1)</sup>—

- (a) the requirement in section 434(1) of the 1996 Act for the proprietor<sup>(2)</sup> of a school to cause to be kept a register containing the prescribed particulars in respect of all persons who are pupils at the school;
- (b) the requirement in section 434(3)(b) of the 1996 Act that the name of a pupil shall only be deleted from a register on a prescribed ground;
- (c) the requirement in regulation 3 of the Education (Information about Individual Pupils) (England) Regulations 2006<sup>(3)</sup> to provide the information set out in Schedule 1 to those Regulations to the local authority which maintain a school within fourteen days of the receipt of a request for that information by that local authority.

(1) “Compulsory school age” is defined in section 8 of the Education Act 1996.

(2) “Proprietor” is defined in section 579 of the Education Act 1996. In relation to a community, foundation or voluntary school, it means the governing body of the school.
