**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation
Display Teams) (No. 3) (Amendment) Regulations 2011**

Made - - - at 1100 hours on 26th August 2011

Coming into force - - - with immediate effect

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying by reason of the intended holding of flying displays by a jet formation display team.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Teams) (No. 3) (Amendment) Regulations 2011 and come into force with immediate effect.

2.—(1) The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Teams) (No.3) Regulations 2011(b) are amended as follows.

(2) The entries in the Schedule beginning with the second entry relating to Clacton and ending with the entry relating to Hoylake are omitted.

(3) In column 4 of the Schedule, in relation to the entry for South Shields, for “19 September 2011” substitute “18 September 2011”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Teams) (No.3) Regulations 2011 (S.I. 2011/1574) by deleting the entries relating to cancelled air displays by the Red Arrows. They also amend the date of the flying restriction applicable to the intended display at South Shields (now due to take place on 18th September 2011).
