The Plant Protection Products Regulations 2011

Labelling

17. A person must not place on the market a plant protection product in contravention of Article 65(1), or cause or permit another person to do so, unless the plant protection product is—

- (a) placed on the market before 14th June 2015;
- (b) approved under the 1986 Regulations, the Plant Protection Products Regulations 2005(1) or the Plant Protection Products (Scotland) Regulations 2005(2); and
- (c) labelled in accordance with Article 16 of Council Directive 91/414/EEC concerning the placing of plant protection products on the market (3)^{F1} as it had effect immediately before 14th June 2011].
