ROAD TRAFFIC

The M62 Motorway (Junction 34 Junction 35) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2011

Made - - - 29th September 2011

Coming into force - 6th October 2011

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M62 Motorway and connecting roads, in the District of Selby, in the County of North Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on that motorway should be restricted because bridge parapet repair works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the M62 Motorway (Junction 34 to Junction 35) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 6th October 2011.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, no person shall, during the period starting at 00:01 hours on Friday 7th October 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the M62 Motorway eastbound carriageway or westbound carriageway from a point 1800 metres west of the centreline of Little Heck Railway Bridge to a point 1800 metres east of the centreline of that bridge, a distance of 3600 metres.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer in uniform.

4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(b) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
