**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M5 Motorway (Junctions 14-13, Michael Wood Services)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - - *4th October 2011*  
*Coming into force* - - - *8th October 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M5 Motorway (“the M5”), is satisfied that traffic on two connecting roads between Junctions 14 and 13 in the County of Gloucestershire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M5 Motorway (Junctions 14-13, Michael Wood Services) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 8th October 2011.

2. In this Order –

“the slip roads” means (a) the northbound entry slip road at Michael Woods Services; and (b) the southbound entry slip road at Michael Woods Services;

“the works” mean signage replacement, lighting column removal and verge-grading works;

“a works period” means a period of 4 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 10th October 2011 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip roads.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to: (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes; (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; (c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
