- [F25.—(1) A person who plants vines of more than 0.1 hectare, or who has increased an existing plantation of vines to one of more than 0.1 hectare, must notify the Agency of the location of the vineyard and the variety or varieties of grape vine planted.
- (2) The notification required by paragraph (1) must be given within 6 months of the date of the event which triggered that requirement.]
