## Warning notices E+W+S

- **10.**—(1) An authorised officer who believes that a person has contravened any provision of the [F1 retained EU Regulations][F2 or the 1416/2006 prohibition] may serve a notice under this regulation on the person (a "warning notice").
  - (2) A warning notice must—
    - (a) state the provision of the [FI retained EU Regulations] that the officer believes has been breached [F3 or, if relevant, state that the officer believes that the 1416/2006 prohibition has been contravened];
    - (b) notify the person that any future breach of that provision by them may render the person liable to prosecution; and
    - (c) give details of the right of appeal against the notice.
