The Postal Packets (Revenue and Customs) Regulations 2011

Made - - - - - *19th December 2011*
Laid before the House of
Commons - - - - - *20th December 2011*
Coming into force - - - - - *10th January 2012*

The Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 105(2) and 122 of the Postal Services Act 2000 ^{M1}, and on the recommendation of the Commissioners for Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs ^{M2} and the Secretary of State, make the following Regulations.

- M2** The functions of the Commissioners of Customs and Excise were transferred to the Commissioners for Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs by section 5(2) of the [Commissioners for Revenue and Customs Act 2005 \(c. 11\)](#). Section 50(1) of that Act provides that a reference to the Commissioners of Customs and Excise shall be taken as a reference to the Commissioners for Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs.
