SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS AND PENSIONS

Increase in rate of graduated retirement benefit

- 12.—(1) In section 36(1) of the National Insurance Act 1965 M1 (graduated retirement benefit)—
 - (a) the sum of 11.53 pence shall be increased by 3.1 per cent.; and
 - (b) from and including 11th April 2011 the reference in that provision to that sum shall have effect as a reference to 11.89 pence.
- (2) The sums which are the increases of graduated retirement benefit under Schedule 2 to the Social Security (Graduated Retirement Benefit) (No. 2) Regulations 1978 M2 (increases for deferred retirement) shall be increased by 3.1 per cent.
- (3) The sums which are lump sums to which surviving spouses or civil partners will become entitled under Schedule 1 to the Social Security (Graduated Retirement Benefit) Regulations 2005 M3 (increases of graduated retirement benefit and lump sums) shall be increased by 3.1 per cent.
- (4) The sums which are the additions under section 37(1) of the National Insurance Act 1965 (additions for widows and widowers) shall be increased by 3.1 per cent.
