The Hull and Goole Port Health Authority Order 2011

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Hull and Goole Port Health Authority Order 2011 and shall come into force on 24th March 2011.
 - (2) The Order applies in relation to England.
 - (3) In this Order—
 - "the Act" means the Public Health (Control of Disease) Act 1984;
 - "the joint board" means the joint board established under article 3;
 - "the Port of Humber" means the port of that name established for the purposes of the enactments for the time being in force relating to customs or excise; and
 - "the proper officer", in relation to any purpose and any body, means the officer appointed for that purpose by that body.
- (4) The riparian authorities specified for the purposes of this Order are the Kingston upon Hull City Council, East Riding of Yorkshire Council and North Lincolnshire Council.
- (5) References in this Order to reference points shall be construed as references to National Grid reference points.
