**The Care Quality Commission (Registration and Membership) (Amendment) Regulations 2012**

**Amendments to the Care Quality Commission (Registration) Regulations 2009**

In regulations 16(4) (notification of death of service user) and 18(4) (notification of other incidents) of the Care Quality Commission (Registration) Regulations 2009<sup>(1)</sup>, for the reference to “the National Patient Safety Agency” substitute “the NHS Commissioning Board Authority established under article 2 of the NHS Commissioning Board Authority (Establishment and Constitution) Order 2011”<sup>(2)</sup>.

<sup>(2)</sup> The NHS Commissioning Board Authority was established under article 2 of the NHS Commissioning Board Authority (Establishment and Constitution) Order 2011 ([S.I. 2011/2237](#)). From 1st June 2012, the NHS Commissioning Board Authority is to be responsible for the functions currently carried out by the National Patient Safety Agency, established under article 2 of the National Patient Safety Agency (Establishment and Constitution) Order 2001 ([S.I. 2001/1743](#)), in relation to the National Reporting and Learning System. Under this system deaths or serious incidents may be reported by a health service body, as defined in regulation 2 of [S.I. 2009/3112](#), to the National Patient Safety Agency instead of to the Care Quality Commission.
