### The Cattle Compensation (England) Order 2012

Made---16th May 2012Laid before Parliament30th May 2012Coming into force-1st July 2012

The powers conferred by sections 1 and 32(3) of the Animal Health Act 1981(1) are vested(2) in the Secretary of State who, in exercise of those powers and with the approval of the Treasury, makes the following Order.
