The Individual Ascertainment of Value (England) Order 2012

Made---16th May 2012Laid before Parliament30th May 2012Coming into force-1st July 2012

The powers conferred by sections 1, 32(3) and 34(7) of the Animal Health Act 1981(1) are vested(2) in the Secretary of State who, in exercise of those powers and with the approval of the Treasury for the purpose of section 32(3), makes the following Order.
