The Forest Law Enforcement, Governance and Trade Regulations 2012

Review

13.—(1) The Secretary of State must from time to time—

- (a) carry out a review of these Regulations;
- (b) set out the conclusions of the review in a report; and
- (c) publish the report.

(2) In carrying out the review the Secretary of State must, so far as is reasonable, have regard to how the European Regulations are enforced in other member States.

- (3) The report must in particular—
 - (a) set out the objectives intended to be achieved by these Regulations;
 - (b) assess the extent to which those objectives are achieved; and
 - (c) assess whether those objectives remain appropriate and, if so, the extent to which they could be achieved in a less burdensome way.
- [^{F1}(4) The first report under this regulation must be published on or before 20th February 2022.]

(5) Reports under this regulation are afterwards to be published at intervals not exceeding five years.
