**The Forest Law Enforcement,
Governance and Trade Regulations 2012**

Review

- 13.**—(1) The Secretary of State must from time to time—
- (a) carry out a review of these Regulations;
 - (b) set out the conclusions of the review in a report; and
 - (c) publish the report.
- (2) In carrying out the review the Secretary of State must, so far as is reasonable, have regard to how the European Regulations are enforced in other member States.
- (3) The report must in particular—
- (a) set out the objectives intended to be achieved by these Regulations;
 - (b) assess the extent to which those objectives are achieved; and
 - (c) assess whether those objectives remain appropriate and, if so, the extent to which they could be achieved in a less burdensome way.
- [^{F1}(4) The first report under this regulation must be published on or before 20th February 2022.]
- (5) Reports under this regulation are afterwards to be published at intervals not exceeding five years.
