The A38 Trunk Road (A5148/A5206 Roundabout, Lichfield, Staffordshire) (Derestriction) Order 2012

 Made
 12th July 2012

 Coming into force
 26th July 2012

The Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of the powers conferred by section 82(2) and 83(1) of, and paragraph 27(1) of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (A5148/A5206 Roundabout, Lichfield, Staffordshire) (Derestriction) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 26th July 2012.

2. In this Order –

"the A38" means the A38 Trunk Road at Lichfield in the County of Staffordshire;

"the roundabout" means the circulatory carriageway of the A38 at its roundabout junction with and the A5206 and the slip roads leading to and from the A5148;

- 3. The lengths of the A38 and connecting roads, that is -
 - (a) the roundabout;
 - (b) the A38 from its junction with the roundabout to a point 56 metres southeast of that roundabout;
 - (c) a length of the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the A5148 from the roundabout, from its junction with the roundabout to a point 42 metres southwest of that roundabout; and
 - (d) a length of the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the A38 from the roundabout, from its junction with the roundabout to a point 25.5 metres northeast of that roundabout;

shall cease to be restricted roads for the purposes of section 81 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

4. Any previous order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or any enactment replaced by that Act which provided that the A38 Trunk Road or any part thereof should cease to be a restricted road is amended by excluding any reference to the lengths of A38 Trunk Road or connecting roads described in article 3 of this Order.
