The Safeguarding Vulnerable Groups Act 2006 (Miscellaneous Provisions) Order 2012

Exceptions from regulated activity relating to vulnerable adults

4. The provision to an adult of health care (as defined in paragraph 7(2) of Schedule 4 to the Act(1)) by a person who is not, but who acts under the direction or supervision of, a health care professional (as defined in paragraph 7(3) of Schedule 4 to the Act(2)) is not to be treated as a regulated activity relating to vulnerable adults where that health care—

- (a) is provided under regulations under Part 6 of the National Health Service Act 2006(3) or Part 6 of the National Health Service (Wales) Act 2006(4) in practice premises or as mobile services; or
- (b) is provided in a registered pharmacy (within the meaning of Part IV of the Medicines Act 1968(5)).
