## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The A3 Trunk Road (Stoke Interchange – Hog's Back Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - 20th August 2012

Coming into force - - 8th September 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A3 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on lengths of that road and on one of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A3 Trunk Road (Stoke Interchange – Hog's Back Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 8th September 2012.

## 2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A3 Trunk Road near Guildford in the County of Surrey;

"a length of carriageway" means –

- (i) the southbound carriageway of the trunk road between Stoke Interchange (A320) and Hog's Back Interchange (A31), or
- (ii) the northbound carriageway of the trunk road between University Interchange (Egerton Road) and Stoke Interchange (A320);

"the slip road" means the road leading from the A322/A25 to the southbound carriageway of the trunk road at Dennis Interchange;

"works" mean resurfacing and bridge maintenance work on the trunk road; and

"a works period" means a period of -

- (i) 7½ hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 10 September 2012 or on any subsequent day other than a Friday or Saturday,
- (ii) 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Friday 14th September 2012 or on any subsequent Friday, or
- (iii) 10 hours starting at 2200 hours on Saturday 15th September 2012 or on any subsequent Saturday,

until 7th March 2014.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a length of carriageway or the slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -
  - (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
  - (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
  - (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
  - (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
