**The A46 Trunk Road (Wanlip and Syston, Leicestershire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

Made - - - - 3rd September 2012

Coming into force - -10th September 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road and one of those connecting roads, between Wanlip and Syston in the County of Leicestershire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (**a**), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A46 Trunk Road (Wanlip and Syston, Leicestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 10th September 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the slip road” means the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the A46 from Fillingate, approximately 700 metres north of the centrepoint of the A6 Wanlip Roundabout;

“layby” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (**b**) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

“the works period” means the period starting at 07.00 hours on Sunday 16th September 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the layby situated adjacent to—

- i) the northbound carriageway of the A46 at Wanlip Roundabout; and
- ii) the southbound carriageway of the A46 from points 23 metres and 106 metres south west of Syston Bypass Railway Bridge.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
