The Police and Crime Commissioner Elections (Welsh Forms) Order 2012

Citation and commencement

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Police and Crime Commissioner Elections (Welsh Forms) Order 2012.
 - (2) This Order comes into force on the day after the day on which it is made.

Welsh and English versions of forms

- **2.**—(1) Each of the forms set out in the Schedule is prescribed as the form of the ballot paper which must be used at a PCC election in Wales in place of—
 - (a) in the case of form A, the form specified by rule 19(1)(a) of the PCC elections rules (ballot paper: three or more candidates);
 - (b) in the case of form B, the form specified by rule 19(1)(b) of the PCC elections rules (ballot paper: two candidates only).
 - (2) In paragraph (1)—
 - "PCC election" means an election of a police and crime commissioner in accordance with Chapter 6 of Part 1 of the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011;
 - "PCC elections rules" means the rules set out in Schedule 3 to the Police and Crime Commissioner Elections Order 2012(1).
