## **CONSUMER CREDIT**

The Consumer Credit (Green Deal) Regulations 2012

Made	7th November 2012
Laid before Parliament	9th November 2012
Coming into force	28th January 2013

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 55(1), 60(1), 77A(2)(1), 95(1)(2), 95B(1)(b) and (3)(c)(3), 97(1)(4), 182(2)(5) and 189(1) of the Consumer Credit Act 1974(6), makes the following Regulations:
