ROAD TRAFFIC

The M1 Motorway (Tibshelf to Junction 28) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2012

Made - - - - *31st December 2012*

Coming into force - - *7th January 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway (“the M1”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that motorway, in the County of Derbyshire, should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and regulation 16(2) of the Motorways Traffic (England and Wales) Regulations 1982(b), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway (Tibshelf to Junction 28) (Temporary 50 Miles Per hour Speed Restriction) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 7th January 2013.

2. In this Order:

| “the motorway” | means the southbound carriageway of the M1 from the centrepont of the disused railway underbridge south of Tibshelf Service Area to a point 800 metres north of the centrepont of the roundabout at M1 Junction 28; |
| “the Regulations” | means the Motorways Traffic (England and Wales) Regulations 1982; |
| “a hard shoulder” | means the hard shoulder, within the meaning of Regulation 3(1)(e) of the Regulations, which is adjacent to the motorway; |
| “the works period” | means the period starting at 04:00 hours on Monday 14th January 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed; |

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the motorway.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) being used for special forces purposes; or
- (c) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.

6. During the works period, regulations 5 and (in so far as it relates to a vehicle being driven) 9 of the Regulations are hereby suspended in respect of a hard shoulder, at such times and to such extent as may from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
