MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

Prescribed time

25. The prescribed⁽¹⁾ time for the purposes of section 206(1)(b) (replacement of trees) and section 213(1)(b)⁽²⁾ (enforcement of controls as respects trees in conservation areas) is whenever the cutting down or uprooting of a tree is authorised only by virtue of regulation 14(1)(a)(i) or 14(1)(c).
