**The Localism Act 2011 (Commencement No. 4 and
Transitional, Transitory and Saving Provisions) Order 2012**

Citation and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Localism Act 2011 (Commencement No. 4 and Transitional, Transitory and Saving Provisions) Order 2012.

(2) In this Order—

“the Act” means the Localism Act 2011;

“the 1961 Act” means the Land Compensation Act 1961(1);

“the 1985 Act” means the Housing Act 1985(2);

“the 1990 Act” means the Town and Country Planning Act 1990(3);

“the 2000 Act” means the Local Government Act 2000(4);

“the 2004 Act” means the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004(5);

“compulsory purchase order” has the same meaning as in the Acquisition of Land Act 1981(6);
and

“special enactment” means—

(a) a local or private Act which authorises the compulsory acquisition of land specifically identified in that Act, or

(b) a provision which—

(i) is contained in an Act other than a local or private Act, and

(ii) authorises the compulsory acquisition of land specifically identified in that Act.
