Local development documents and directions by the Mayor of London

Direction by the Mayor of London

7.—(1) Where the Mayor of London has given a direction under section [^{F1}15(3A), 15(4)] or (8) of the Act to a local planning authority they must send a copy of it to the Secretary of State and, notwithstanding regulation 3(1), they must send—

- (a) one copy electronically; and
- (b) two copies in paper form.

(2) The time prescribed for the purposes of section 15(6B), (8B)(b) and (8C) ^{M1} of the Act is 3 weeks starting on the day the Mayor of London gives the direction in question.
