The Young People's Learning Agency Abolition (Consequential Amendments to Subordinate Legislation) (England) Order 2012

Amendment of the Income Support (General) Regulations 1987

- 3.—(1) The Income Support (General) Regulations 1987 ^{M1} are amended as follows.
- (2) In regulation 2(1) (interpretation) in paragraph (a) of the definition of “training allowance” omit “the Young People's Learning Agency for England”.
- (3) In regulation 61(1) (interpretation)—
- (a) in paragraph (d) of the definition of “access funds”—
 - (i) for “Young People's Learning Agency for England under sections 61 and 62 of the Apprenticeships, Skills, Children and Learning Act 2009” substitute “ Secretary of State under section 14 of the Education Act 2002 ”^{M2}, and
 - (ii) for “that Act” substitute “ the Apprenticeships, Skills, Children and Learning Act 2009 ”;
 - (b) in the definition of “full-time course of advanced education”—
 - (i) in paragraphs (a) and (b) for “Young People's Learning Agency for England” substitute “ Secretary of State under section 14 of the Education Act 2002 ” in each place where those words occur, and
 - (ii) in paragraph (b)(i) for “bodies” substitute “ persons ”; and
 - (c) in the definition of “full-time course of study”—
 - (i) in paragraphs (a) and (b) for “Young People's Learning Agency for England” substitute “ Secretary of State under section 14 of the Education Act 2002 ” in each place where those words occur, and
 - (ii) in paragraph (b)(i) for “bodies” substitute “ persons ”.
- (4) In paragraph 28 of Schedule 1B (persons engaged in training) for “Young People's Learning Agency for England” substitute “ Secretary of State ”.
