Amendment of the Housing Renewal Grants Regulations 1996

6. In regulation 41 (interpretation) of the Housing Renewal Grants Regulations 1996 ^{M1}—
- (a) in paragraph (d) of the definition of “access funds”—
 - (i) for “Young People's Learning Agency for England under sections 61 and 62 of the Apprenticeships, Skills, Children and Learning Act 2009” substitute “ Secretary of State under section 14 of the Education Act 2002 ”, and
 - (ii) for “that Act” substitute “ the Apprenticeships, Skills, Children and Learning Act 2009 ”; and
 - (b) in the definition of “full-time course of study”—
 - (i) in paragraphs (a) and (b) for “Young People's Learning Agency for England” substitute “ Secretary of State under section 14 of the Education Act 2002 ” in each place where those words occur, and
 - (ii) in paragraph (b)(i) for “bodies” substitute “ persons ”.
