**The Immigration (Designation of Travel Bans)
(Amendment No. 2) Order 2013**

<i>Made</i> - - - -	<i>11th July 2013</i>
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	<i>12th July 2013</i>
<i>Coming into force</i> - -	<i>17th July 2013</i>

The Secretary of State makes the following Order in exercise of the power conferred by section 8B(5) of the Immigration Act 1971(a).

1. This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Designation of Travel Bans) (Amendment No. 2) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 17th July 2013.

2. In Part 1 of the Schedule to the Immigration (Designation of Travel Bans) Order 2000(b) after “Resolution 1985 (2011) of 10 June 2011 (Democratic People’s Republic of Korea).” insert “Resolution 2094 (2013) of 7 March 2013 (Democratic People’s Republic of Korea).”.

3.—(1) Part 2 of the Schedule to the Immigration (Designation of Travel Bans) Order 2000 is amended as follows.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends the Schedule to the Immigration (Designation of Travel Bans) Order 2000.
