PART 6

POWERS IN RESPECT OF MOTOR VEHICLES

**Power of seizure**

**24.**—(1) A charging scheme may confer powers on an authorised person to seize anything (if necessary by detaching it from a motor vehicle) and detain it as evidence of the commission of an offence under section 173(5) or (6) of the Transport Act 2000<sup>(1)</sup> (acts done with intent to avoid a road user charge).

(2) The power conferred by paragraph (1) must not be exercised by an authorised person who is not a constable except in the presence of a constable.
