The information you give on this form will be used to compile the Electoral Register which will be published on 2 December 2013. You are required by law to give the information asked for which must be accurate on 15 October 2013. You should complete the form whether you are currently registered or you are registering for the first time. If you do not give the information requested you could be fined up to £1000. Providing false information is a criminal offence for which you could be sent to prison for up to six months or fined £5000 or both. If you do not return this form you may not be included on the electoral register and will not be able to vote at future electors.
