# The Firearms (Amendment) Rules 2013

Made - - - - 23rd July 2013

Coming into force - - 1st December 2013

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 26A(1), 26B(1) and 53 of the Firearms Act 1968(a), makes the following Rules:

### Citation and commencement

1. These Rules may be cited as the Firearms (Amendment) Rules 2013 and shall come into force on 1st December 2013.

### **Amendment to the Firearms Rules 1998**

- **2.** The Firearms Rules 1998(**b**) are amended as follows.
- **3.** In rule 3 (firearm certificates)—
  - (a) for paragraph (1), substitute—
    - "An application for the grant or renewal of a firearm certificate shall be in the form set out in Part 1 of Schedule 1.";
  - (b) in paragraph (2), for the words "1 to 16" substitute "1 to 18";
  - (c) after paragraph (6), insert—
    - "(7) An application for the variation of a firearm certificate shall be in the form set out in Part IV of Schedule 1."
- 4. In rule 4 (referees: firearm certificates), omit paragraph (4).
- 5. In rule 5(2) (shotgun certificates), for the words "1 to 16" substitute "1 to 14, and 19 to 21."
- **6.** In rule 7 (photographs to accompany application)—
  - (a) before the words "the photographs," insert "(1)";
  - (b) at the end, insert the following—
    - "(2) Where an applicant applies for a firearm certificate and a shotgun certificate simultaneously using the prescribed form in Part 1 of Schedule 1, the applicant need only submit a total of four photographs."

- 7. In Schedule 1 (firearm certificates: forms of application and certificate)—
  - (a) for the heading, substitute "Form of Application for Firearm and Shotgun Certificates, and Firearm Certificate";
  - (b) for the form in Part 1 (application for a firearm certificate), substitute the form in Schedule 1 to these Regulations (application for the grant or renewal of a firearm or shotgun certificate);
  - (c) after Part III, insert Part IV as set out in Schedule 2 to these Rules (application to vary a firearm certificate).
- **8.** In Schedule 2 (shotgun certificates: forms of application and certificate)—
  - (a) for the heading, substitute "Shotgun Certificate";
  - (b) omit Part 1 (application for shotgun certificate).

### General

**9.** An application for a firearm certificate or a shotgun certificate may continue to be made using an application form which is replaced or omitted by virtue of rule 7(b) or 8(b) above if it is received by the chief officer of police for the area in which the applicant resides on or before 1st January 2014.

### NOTES

Please read these BEFORE completing the form

FIREARM: Section 1 of the Firearms Act 1968 (as amended) applies to all firearms except:

- i, a shotgun;
- ii. an air weapon (unless declared 'specially dangerous');
- iii, prohibited weapons such as centrefire selfloading rifles, handguns, machine guns etc (unless specifically authorised).

Shotgun: Section 1(3)a of the Firearms Act. 1968 (as amended) defines a shotgun as:

- a smooth bore gun (not being an air weapon);
- ii. having a barrel not less than 24" (60.96cm) and a bore less than 2" (5.08cm);
- either having no magazine, or a nondetachable magazine incapable of holding more than two cartridges;
- iv. not a revolver gun.
- You must not withhold information about any conviction. This includes motoring offences, binding
  overs, formal written warnings, cautions and convictions in and outside Great Britain, and (by virtue
  of the Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974 (Exceptions) Order 1975) convictions which are spent
  under the 1974 Act. A conditional discharge and an absolute discharge both count as convictions
  for this purpose. Details of parking offences and fixed penalty notices do not need to be declared.
- 2. Applications must be accompanied by four identical photographs of you and sized 45mm x 35mm. The photographs must be full face and without a hat and must be a current true likeness. Ordinary passport style photographs are suitable for this purpose. A computer generated likeness is acceptable if it is full face, against a plain background and printed on good quality gloss or matt paper. If you are applying for both a firearm and a shotgun certificate you need only submit four photographs.
- One of the photographs must be signed in ink, on the back by you, the applicant. Each of the referees must endorse a further separate photograph, in ink with her/his signature and the date the likeness was compared.
- 4. Unless otherwise advised by the police, you should post or take the completed form together with the fee and photographs to the police firearms licensing department. In the case of an application for renewal of a shotgun certificate, the current certificate or a signed and dated recent copy should be included with the application.
- Personal health and medical declaration. You must disclose any physical or mental health condition
  that may affect your ability to safely possess and use a firearm (including a shotgun). This includes
  for example epilepsy, stroke, stress related illness, depression, alcoholism, heart disease, cancer
  etc. If in doubt, consult your GP.
- Where an application is successful a letter will be sent to your GP and where there is good reason a medical report may be required.
- 7. To apply for both a firearm certificate and a shotgun certificate and to have them expire at the same time (coterminous certificates) you should complete the sections for firearm and shotgun certificates. The fee payable for such certificates may be less than the normal fee for the grant or renewal of a shotgun certificate if both of your application forms are dealt with at the same time.
- 8. (1) To acquire or possess firearms or ammunition under Section 1 of the Firearms Act 1968, you have to provide evidence that you have a good reason to do so. This applies to the grant, renewal or variation of a firearm certificate. This evidence can take several forms: permission to shoot over land or membership of a target shooting club, or a booking or invitation to go deer stalking are examples, but these are not exhaustive.

(2) Please provide the address of one area of land where you have permission to shoot, together with the name, address and telephone number of the person who has given you that permission or the details of a Home Office approved club of which you are a full member. NB: You will not necessarily be limited to shooting over that individual piece of land or at that club.

- 9. You must complete parts A and B before passing the form to your referee(s) for signing.
- 10. When applying for a firearm certificate, two people who have agreed to act as referees must complete Part F (i & ii) and when applying for a shotgun certificate one person who has agreed to act as referee must complete part F (i).
- 11. The referee(s) who have agreed to act for you must have known you personally for at least two years and must be resident in Great Britain. Referees must not be a member of your family, a registered firearms dealer, a serving police officer or police employee. Referees must be of good character and references must be given freely and not on payment.
- 12. The equality monitoring information you provide in Part G aims to assist the force in meeting its duties as a Public Authority. The information will be kept separately from the application.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Rules)

These Rules replace the existing two application forms for a firearm certificate and a shotgun certificate with one new single application form that applies for the purposes of both applications. Rule 7(c) introduces a new prescribed application form for an application for the variation of a firearm certificate. Rule 8 removes the old application for a shotgun certificate.

Rule 6 clarifies the requirements that apply in relation to photographs that must accompany an application, in circumstances where an applicant applies simultaneously for a firearm certificate and a shotgun certificate using the new single form.

Rule 9 makes provision to enable chief officers of police to process applications for a firearm certificate or a shotgun certificate which are made using the old forms that are to be replaced, provided that the application concerned is submitted on or before 1st January 2014.

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
