5. Fellowship or Membership of the Institute of Food Science and Technology.

6. In paragraphs 1 and 2 of this Part, "degree" means a degree awarded by a body recognised for the purposes of section 214 of the Education Reform Act 1988 (which relates to bodies empowered to award degrees in the United Kingdom) or by a university in [^{F2}a Member State of the European Union].
