DISTRIBUTOR OBLIGATIONS AND RIGHTS: WEEE FROM PRIVATE HOUSEHOLDS

Record keeping

- **45.**—(1) A distributor to whom the regulation 42 applies [FI must] keep a record of the number of units of WEEE from private households that are returned to him under that regulation.
- (2) A distributor who returns WEEE from private households under regulation 43 [FI must] keep a record of the number of units of WEEE from private households returned by him under that regulation.
- (3) Each distributor to whom the obligation in regulation 44 applies [FImust] keep a record of the information made available under that regulation.
- (4) The records referred to in this regulation [FImust] be kept for a period of at least four years commencing on the date on which any such record is made and [FImust] be made available to the Secretary of State on demand.
