APPLICATION

Exemptions

- 7. These Regulations do not apply to EEE which is-
 - (a) necessary for the protection of the essential interests of the security of [^{F1}the United Kingdom], including arms, munitions and war material intended for specifically military purposes;
 - (b) specifically designed and installed as part of another type of equipment that is excluded from or does not fall within the scope of [^{F2}these Regulations], which can fulfil its function only if it is part of that equipment;
 - (c) filament bulbs.
