DUTIES OF THE APPROPRIATE AUTHORITIES

**Approval of authorised treatment facilities and exporters**

**81.**—(1) The appropriate authority [<sup>F1</sup>must] maintain and publish a list of all AATFs, operators of AATFs and approved exporters.

(2) The appropriate authority [<sup>F2</sup>must] publish the format in which [<sup>F3</sup>—

- (a) the information referred to in Part 1 of Schedule 11 must be submitted to it in an application for approval made under regulation 61 or in an application for an extension of a grant of approval made under regulation 62][<sup>F4</sup>, and
- (b) the reports referred to in regulation 66 must be submitted to it in accordance with that regulation.]
