# Approval of authorised treatment facilities and exporters



# Conditions of approval of exporters

[<sup>F1</sup>28. An evidence note may be issued only in relation to WEEE that —

- (a) has arisen as waste in the United Kingdom;
- (b) is to be exported for reuse as a whole appliance;
- (c) is to be export to an establishment or undertaking located outside the United Kingdom that has been notified to the appropriate authority in accordance with regulation 61 and paragraph 7(a) or regulation 62;
- (d) is to be exported in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 1013/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council on shipments of waste.]

**29.** [<sup>F2</sup>The amount of WEEE recorded on an evidence note must be recorded in tonnes but any fraction of a whole tonne must be recorded in kilograms and such a fraction must be—]

- (a) rounded up to the nearest whole kilogram where the part kilogram is 0.5 or more; and
- (b) rounded down to the nearest whole kilogram where the part kilogram is less than 0.5.

**39.** Where an exporter has submitted an application for approval under regulation 61(1) which was accompanied by the fee specified in regulation 65(1)(a) and he subsequently issues evidence notes for in excess of 400 tonnes of WEEE in the approval period to which the application relates, the exporter must pay the fee specified in regulation 65(1)(b) in the period to which the approval relates, less the amount of the fee already paid which is specified in regulation 65(1)(a).
