REVISION ON SPECIFIC GROUNDS

Award of another benefit

12. Where—

- (a) the Secretary of State makes a decision to award a benefit to a claimant (“the original award”); and
- (b) an award of another relevant benefit [^{F1}or [^{F2}Scottish disability benefit]] or of an increase in the rate of another relevant benefit [^{F1}or [^{F2}Scottish disability benefit]] is made to the claimant or, in the case of universal credit, to a member of their family, for a period which includes the date on which the original award took effect,

the Secretary of State may revise the original award.
