The Social Security Benefits Up-rating Order 2013

PART 2

SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS AND PENSIONS

Rates of age addition

13.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), in regulation 10(2) of the Social Security (Incapacity Benefit) Regulations 1994⁽¹⁾ (increase in rate of incapacity benefit where beneficiary is under prescribed age on the qualifying date)—

- (a) in sub-paragraph (a) for “£20.25” substitute “£20.70”; and
- (b) in sub-paragraph (b) for “£10.15” substitute “£10.35”.

(2) In the case of a claimant entitled to long-term incapacity benefit—

- (a) the sum specified in regulation 10(2)(a)(2) shall be reduced to “£10.70”; and
- (b) the sum specified in regulation 10(2)(b) shall be increased to “£6.00”.
