[^{F1}Industrial Emissions Directive: large combustion plant

11A. Where a permit relates to a large combustion plant, the Secretary of State must exercise the Secretary of State's functions under these Regulations so as to ensure compliance with the following provisions of the 2010 Directive—

- (a) Article 29;
- (b) Article 30(1) and 30(3) to (8) [^{F2}except that the Secretary of State has no obligation to inform the Commission of any derogation granted under paragraph (5) or (6)];
- (c) Article 37;
- (d) Article 38;
- (e) Article 39;
- (f) Article 40(1).]
